Ryde Rehabilitation Centre is to be given a new lease of life. This excellent facility is unique to Sydney.

Former Member for Bennelong and Prime Minister, John Howard made a commitment for some \$12 Million towards the Rehab Centre. Since the 2007 Federal Election, I have asked the current Member for Bennelong, Maxine McKew as to whether or not the Federal Government would honour in part if not in whole, this commitment.

The \$12 Million pledge would possibly have alleviated the need for the construction of the housing development on this site.

The underpass is in need of widening and this should occur as Victoria Road is a major transport corridor through our electorate.
